REGISTER for the ColonCancerCheck (CCC) **Patient Attachment program**. Earn \$150-\$230 for enrolling a new unattached patient who is at increased risk of colorectal cancer or has an abnormal FIT result (billing code Q043A).

SIGN UP for the **Screening Activity Report (SAR)**. The SAR is an online tool for physicians that provides patient level screening data for breast, cervical and colorectal cancers. The SAR includes lists of your patients who require follow-up of an abnormal screening result or are overdue for cancer screening.
