Breast Screening: Average Risk People Ages 40-49

REMINDER: People ages 40-49 at average risk of developing breast cancer are <u>NOT</u> currently eligible for screening through the Ontario Breast Screening program (OBSP)

Current Process for Screening Mammography for People Ages 40-49:

 People ages 40-49 are encouraged to make a personal decision about screening in consultation with their family doctor or nurse practitioner and can be referred for a screening mammogram <u>outside of the OBSP</u>.

Expansion of the OBSP Fall 2024:

- The <u>OBSP</u> will expand to include people ages 40-49 in the fall of 2024.
- More information will be provided when an official go-live date is announced by Ontario Health.
