## **Upcoming Changes to the Ontario Cervical Screening Program** (OCSP): HPV Testing Implementation - Spring 2025

Human Papillomavirus (HPV) testing will replace cytology as the primary test for cervical screening and will also be used for follow-up testing in colposcopy starting in spring 2025

## New! HPV Testing in Ontario: Implementation Resource Hub for Primary Care Providers

To help primary care providers prepare for the implementation of HPV testing in 2025, Ontario Health has launched a website with tools and resources including information about:

- Why HPV testing is being implemented in the OCSP
- · Changes to the OCSP's screening recommendations, including
  - Eligibility for screening and management of results
  - Guidance for vaginal vault testing
- Changes to the OCSP's colposcopy pathways

- For patients who are overdue or due for cervical cancer screening, please continue to use cytology-based screening until HPV testing is implemented as part of the OCSP.
- Cervical screening with a Pap test is safe, accurate and allows people to receive key benefits of organized screening (e.g., correspondence letters).
